## MORBID APPEARANCES.

## Chest.

Well nourished muscular body. Recent abrasions on the nose & above the right eye. Deep cyanosis of lips & face. No other external marks of injury.

Tough adhesions on both sides

Lungs = 180gms each. Both very deeply congested. Both emphysematous.

No pulmonary embolism. There is marked chronic bronchitis, with a recent acute attack all the lobes being plugged with mucus. The trachea is full of mucus. Larynx shows chronic inflammation.

Thyroid normal. Pericardium healthy.

Heart = 120g is firmly contracted. The heart muscle shows diffuse disorganized fibrosis. The valves are competent but the aortic mitral are a little attenuated. The coronary arteries are diffusely atheromatous & there is atheroma of the aorta. All the great veins in the chest & in the neck are engorged with blood. Puncture of the Innominate vein produces a jet of blood ascending quite 6 inches from the level of the nasal wall.

## Abdomen

Peritoneum natural.

Liver = 3 lbs 5oz is congested. Gall bladder normal.

Spleen = 4oz normal.

Pancreas normal. Kidneys = 6oz each congested. Adrenals prot.

Bladder normal. Alimentary Canal full & normal. Stomach contains food & mucus of feces. Intestines natural.

## Cranium

Skull natural. Meninges normal. Brain is healthy but very bloodless. The vessels of the Circle of Willis are very atheromatous. No embolism found.

well nourished muscular body. Recent abrasions on the nose & above the right eye. Deep cyanosis of lips & face. No other external marks of injury.

Chest:

Lungs <sup>normal</sup> ~~show~~ adhesions on both sides.

Lungs = 160g each. Both very deeply congested. Both emphysematous.

There is marked chronic bronchitis, with a recent acute attack all the tubes being plugged with mucus. The trachea is full of mucus. Larynx shows chronic inflammation.

Thyroid normal. Pericardium healthy.

Heart = 120g is firmly contracted. The heart muscle shows diffuse disorganized fibrils. The valves are competent but the aortic mitral are a little atheromatous. In coronary arteries are diffusely atheromatous & there is atheroma of the aorta. All the great veins in the chest & in the neck are engorged with blood. Puncture of the Innominate vein produces a jet of blood ascending quite 4 inches from the level of the canal wall.

Abdomen

Peritoneum natural.

Liver = 310g & 50g is congested. Gall bladder normal.

Spleen = 43g normal.

Pancreas normal. Kidneys = 60g each congested. Adrenals good.

Bladder normal. Abdominal Canal full of normal. Stomach contains food & smells of feces. Intestines natural.

Cranium

Skull natural. Meninges normal. Brain is healthy but very bloodless. The vessels of the Arachnoid of the sides are very atheromatous. No embolism found.
