

 instead of being perfectly smooth as in health was roughly tuberculated - This change was due to a splitting up of the gland into several lobules. The peculiarity first mentioned was best exhibited by the left gland which was smaller than normal and broken up into islands each of which consisted of cortex and medulla (both of normal colour); but the cortical matter here and there contained a hard calcareous deposit which stopped the progress of the knife.
 The right gland was larger than its fellow, without exceeding normal dimensions. The tubulation was not here carried to the same extent, although the surface was irregular, but the lower half of the structure was extremely calcareous and to the finger conveyed the impression of a rough stone. In this some of the purplish filaments could be seen to penetrate the tunicae glandula presented to the naked eye no abnormality

On the 10th was much the same; less prostrate.

... 11th bowels partly open: not exactly diarrhoea. Tongue clean

Throat less so: rash fading: desquamation on arms & trunk.

Today she seems stronger. Face less swollen.

Pans very little urine herself. It accumulates in the bladder.

Cough & expectoration less.
