MORBID APPEARANCES

Genl appear Height 5ft 5in. Hair grey.
 Body fairly brownish -
 An opening into urethra from Perineum made to examine a growth from the urethra.

Pleurae. Recent thick yellow lymph on visceral & parietal surfaces on Right side - a few old adhesions on left side.

Pleuritis

Collapses The lower lobe of right lung cut little wet-chamoise, is tough, does not crepitate & sinks in water.

Bronchitis The upper lobes of right lung on section of a very red color, crepitate, bronchial tubes thickened & on pressure mucous exudes.

Congestion Left lung on section of dark red color in posterior lobe, crepitate & floats in water. Anterior portion normal - Bronchii, much injected with vessels & covered with thick mucous -

Heart 21 oz. Surface covered with thick layer of fat.

Hypertrophy Valves & Orifices healthy, muscle thickened

Liver 5lb 3oz Surface even fatty, clean

Spleen On section very pale in portal bow. 10oz. Rather pale & flabby

Kidneys 14 oz Capsule slightly adherent; Surface slightly granular, Cortis acid, Malpighian bodies not remarkably prominent

A stout, old man with scanty grey hair. Little but numerous in white.

Bladder - Contracted - Inner surface hypertrophied of a purplish red color & very fasciculated - Walls thickened -

Urethra - An opening into the Urethra from the perineum - Growing in the walls of the urethra is a soft granular, palish pink friable substance - It extended along the tube for three inches in front of the triangular ligament & was about half an inch in thickness.

Pus in Dorsal vein of Urethra

The Dorsal vein of Penis, just at the pubic arch contained some creamy pus.

CASE

A short, old man with scanty grey hair. Often had gonorrhoea in youth. Had suffered for 17 years from a stricture. Seven years ago had been under the care of Mr Holt at Westminster.

7 months ago was in St Peter's Hospital for 6 weeks under Mr Coulson, who opened a perineal abscess. Since that time all his urine has escaped through this wound.

At one period he was in the habit of substituting himself. Has lately lost much flesh & the skin of the perineum has been growing rapidly in thickness. In the middle line of the perineum is a prominent, hard mass, like granulation substance, forming a hump as large as an egg. All urine escapes through this into the bed. No enlarged glands in groin.

The day after admission an attempt to introduce a catheter failed, much constitutional disturbance followed. The hump on the perineum grew bigger. Eight days after admission, after consultation this was administered. The Dick inserted the mass, where his finger passed into a loose cavity between the bladder & the rectum. The prostate gland felt only a little enlarged. A large abscess, which had set up some oedema of the scrotum & penis, was opened. A syringe was then introduced between the bladder & perineum, the stricture divided & a gum catheter passed through penis into the bladder & tied there. Much local relief followed, but scarcely better some pneumonia at base the right lung. Patient became slightly jaundiced. Course on 879.
